The firearms that are used for the camp need cleaning and inspection. This is an expensive proposition that utilizes about 10% of the funds coming into the camp. Some people offered to pay for part of this service, but we would prefer a long term and ongoing solution rather than just a temporary solution. John also suggested getting a chamber iron for the .22's to work out the occasional dry fire damage to the firearms.

Having scouts using the club has turned out to be a huge success as we charge \$25 a head which provides a significant amount of funds for the club. If anyone has contacts with the 4-H, we would also like to make the same arrangements with those groups as well.

We need to insure that there are a number of SO's available for IDPA matches. Either we will bring in an instructor (from Havana) to train new SO's, or see what needs to be done to get an acceptable course under Safer USA. Without more SO's being available, we will not be able to continue having IDPA shoots throughout the year.
